WHAT IS A LONE WOLF?

A lone wolf is an activist who has no formal affiliation with any organisation, but who is loyal to his or her chosen group and comrades, even if he or she has no contact with them, just like any other activist.

The lone wolf's political work is full-time, his activities encompassing all areas of his life, from the time he gets out of bed in the morning until he goes to bed at night.

The lone wolf is an ambassador for his cause, he must always represent his ideal in the best possible way in the family, at work and at play. He will not speak what he should not or generate unnecessary conflict situations that do not contribute anything to his cause, if he must be silent at a certain time or in a specific situation, he will do so. He will always use his intelligence.

The lone wolf is his own judge of his actions, but his judgement will be based on the extent to which they favour or disfavour his ideas or the organisation he represents. Contrary to what many believe, the lone wolf has more responsibility than the formal members of an organisation. The lone wolf cannot make mistakes because any mistake would harm both the organisation(s) he represents and his comrades. Before any action he must make sure that it will have a positive outcome in his struggle and above all that it will not expose his comrades to the ZOG (Zionist Occupation Government).

WHY BE A LONE WOLF?

The lone wolf strategy is useful in countries where organisations of a particular ideology are banned or where membership may compromise or affect the lives of their members. In recent years, several members of white nationalist organisations have realised that through formal membership the ZOG (Zionist Occupation Government) can gain access to their members, so they have concluded that it is more useful to join an organisation informally and to activate independently, which in turn allows anyone anywhere in the world to become an activist without any prior formalities, thus exponentially increasing the number of active supporters of the organisation.

Being a lone wolf not only allows freedom of action and time, but also the development of creativity and various personal faculties in terms of activism, which awakens the pleasure and enjoyment of activism and generates the desire to continue it.

The lone wolf must be very careful when deciding to engage in activism together with other individuals who claim to share his ideas and goals, often these are not the same and only want his participation, or these "comrades" may harm his activism as a lone wolf either by their mediocrity and desire for the independent activist to share their mediocre actions, or, in the case of subjects with a penchant for violence, he may, due to deeds not committed by him, be discovered by the ZOG, be involved in actions unrelated to his conduct that tarnish the organisation he represents and his comrades and be criminally prosecuted, putting an end to his activism.

The lone wolf is the best strategy of militancy, but, I will repeat again, it carries with it a great responsibility.

HOW SHOULD A LONE WOLF BEHAVE?

The lone wolf must reject any violent action, and if he has to resort to violence it must be in a defensive way and always avoiding the enemy to take the role of victim. Obtaining this role is of paramount importance, as it can be crucial to stalk a blow to the enemy or advance our cause.

Victims generate sympathy and solidarity from society, while perpetrators generate contempt and repudiation. If you are hurt or harmed in a confrontation, it does not mean that you have lost, but quite the opposite. It is possible that this small fact will lead a large part of society to sympathise with your ideas or to "not see them as bad" and to find your enemy and his ideas undesirable.

You should never start a confrontation, you should always let the enemy initiate them, try to avoid them as far as possible, as sometimes in the need to defend yourself you may hurt your aggressor and he may get the desired role of victim.

If you find yourself in the presence of enemy supporters, you should not show hostility to them but try to gently make them think and convince them of the erroneousness of their beliefs. If you take activists or sympathisers away from the enemy, you are doing him a great disservice. It is important not to forget that your activism is not only limited to those who are not clear about an idea or belief, but that you must also operate on the enemy's proselytes.

Try to stay close to people, do not adopt violent or antisocial postures, do not alienate others at all, but on the contrary, keep them close to you in order to carry out your mission.

Sometimes it is very useful to pretend to share a taste for a sport, a hobby or a popular style of music, believe it or not this will give people a good idea of you and the cause you are campaigning for, whenever you can brand the enemy's

personality to ordinary people or even to their sympathisers and activists, contrasting it with your own.

The lone wolf must always behave in view of his cause and his ideas.

WHAT CAN I DO AS A LONE WOLF?

As a lone wolf you have a wide field of action, you can distribute propaganda and literature of your organisation, always being careful not to be discovered in case the laws of your country prohibit your organisation's ideas, you can create your own personal propaganda and literature according to your ideas, you can find the best way to carry out your activism according to your possibilities, and you can approach people or organisations that share certain ideas or intentions and try to broaden the common ground.

The latter is of utmost importance, as it makes it possible for your ideas to slowly begin to be accepted and legitimised.

These are just a few of the things you can do, use your imagination and you will find many more ways to do your activism in an effective and enjoyable way. What makes an activist strategy viable or not is whether or not it is positive for your organisation and your ideas.

WHAT CAN'T I DO AS A LONE WOLF?

As a lone wolf you may not take any action that harms in any way the ideas you stand and fight for.

Therefore no violent action is allowed, so if a like-minded group is planning a violent action stay away immediately and break all ties.

Always avoid the company of Hollywood Nazis, these guys are not representatives of our ideas, they only seek to satisfy their desires for power and violence. They have been created by the ZOG to be used for their purposes and it is through them that they manage to reach activists who are of interest to them.

If you find yourself in the company of mediocre or unproductive individuals, walk away and return to your solitary activism. Remember that you cannot win without intelligence, our enemy is so intelligent that he can make us work for him willingly or self-destruct by believing that we are fighting him effectively, therefore you can only stand up to him and win a victory over him if you are smarter.

Abandon all bad habits, don't identify yourself with badges on your clothes, don't give an image of aggressiveness, show yourself and behave in a gentle manner. Defence is only a phase you are obliged to go through and not the essence of our

worldview, therefore any stance in favour of violence is alien and foreign to our ideas.

It doesn't matter if you are called a coward or a bum, it only matters what you do and the result of your actions. You must always keep your goal in mind and only be loyal to it.

WHAT IS THE AIM OF THE LONE WOLF?

The lone wolf has only one goal: the advancement of his cause. Therefore, before any action, he must first think about whether or not it benefits the cause. No criterion can judge an action as right or wrong other than the result it has for our cause.

The aim in the life of the lone wolf is to do everything possible for the realisation of his ideas, and when he dies he must leave the way for those who follow him in the struggle.

DIFFERENT TYPES OF LONE WOLF ACTIVISM

Ghost activism

This type of activism consists of setting up an organisation that has no real existence and militating on behalf of it. This tactic has one major disadvantage: in countries where our activism is banned, the ZOG can imprison us for the crime of unlawful association, which is why founding a ghost organisation is not a good idea under such circumstances.

Anonymous activism

This is the most effective and appropriate practice, which consists of carrying out lone wolf activism on behalf of an organisation set up in a country where its existence is legal. This way the ZOG cannot accuse you of being a member of an illegal organisation because you are not, but be careful, in some countries such as Argentina they can also punish you if they discover that you are collaborating with an organisation that is illegal under the laws of the country, even if it is not in that territory. Here is the safest way to do this strategy.

HOW SHOULD I ACT TO BE A LONE WOLF?

To perform your lone wolf activity correctly you must follow the following steps.

-CREATE A PSEUDONYM OR SEVERAL PSEUDONYMS: use fake names to produce literature or create email accounts.

-KEEP YOUR IDENTITY: go to a business that offers internet service and create an email box with a pseudonym, there are even some sites that allow you to create an email address without requiring a phone number or ID. Never give your phone number to a server when you are creating the email box with which you will do your activism.

This email account can only be opened from public places but NEVER FROM YOUR HOME ADDRESS OR ANYONE ELSE'S HOME ADDRESS. Through this account you will be able to talk to your comrades in the organisation(s) you have decided to represent.

-KEEP YOUR MOVEMENTS: Ideally, you should check your email inbox an interval of a day or two, so that it is not too busy and does not attract the attention of the ZOG. If you cannot print your literature at home, go to a printing shop without attracting the attention of their employees, if possible use a pseudonym if you are asked for your name.

If you must receive information from a comrade by mail, use an address to which you cannot be linked, and tell your comrade to use plain airmail, that is, mail that does not require certification of receipt, and to write under the pseudonym you use.

Don't have compromising information on your computer, store it on a flash drive and use it when you need it. Don't have literature to distribute at home either, just have copies to photocopy. You don't know when the ZOG might break into your home.

Never give out your real details via the email address you use for your lone wolf activism.
