A National Socialist puts a huge swastika flag at the top of a tall industrial chimney. On the way down, he removes several step rings. The next morning this flag is visible throughout the whole city. It takes the fire department several hours to remove it.

My driver points to the grassy hill next to the Autobahn. "Years ago, comrades burned a fifty meter swastika into the grass there. It was visible for miles."

A comrade says he attended a Hitler birthday party (Führersgeburtstagfeier). The whole village was there. Including the mayor.

A comrade is invited to join the public speaker school of a nationalist party. But he cannot say "national democratic." He can only say "National Socialist."

Another comrade becomes a public spokesman for a nationalist political party. He always wears a swastika pin on the INSIDE of his coat lapel. During a television interview the lapel gets turned around. The swastika is visible. On television.

A member of the German parliament (Bundestag) has too much to drink. He walks down the street. Singing a National Socialist song. And gets arrested.

A comrade is putting up NSDAP/AO swastika stickers in the Nuremberg stadium. He sees three policemen approaching. Too late to run. He stands with his back to the wall. Hopes to hide the stickers. The police ask him to step aside. He does. And expects to be immediately arrested.

The three policemen stand at attention. Click their heels. Give the Hitler salute. Turn around. And walk away.
